Ana Mateus is a veterinarian graduated from the Universidade Técnica de Lisboa in 2000. She initially worked in small animal practice in Italy. In 2003, she changed career path, moving to the UK to work in food safety as an Official Veterinary Surgeon. Between 2005 and 2007, she completed a residency and a MSc in veterinary public health (VPH) at the University of Glasgow. She then undertook a PhD at the Royal Veterinary College (RVC) on the use of antimicrobials in small animals. After her PhD, she worked as a postgraduate research assistant at the RVC and completed a traineeship at the European Medicines Agency. Between 2012 and 2014, she worked in Public Health England, undertaking a fellowship in Field Epidemiology. She is a European specialist in VPH (sub-speciality Population Medicine). Since April 2014, she is a Lecturer in VPH at the RVC and her main areas of research are One Health, foodborne zoonotic diseases and antimicrobial resistance.
