## **Elizabeth Mullineaux**

Liz Mullineaux worked in mixed veterinary practice, overseas and in the UK, before settling in the south west of England as a director of a small animal veterinary hospital. Having developed an interest in British wildlife, in 2011 she completed a clinical doctorate investigating the factors influencing badger rehabilitation and release. She now works as Scientific Advisor to Secret World Wildlife Rescue (a wildlife charity specializing in badger rehabilitation), alongside part-time roles in small animal emergency medicine and academia. Her main interest is the appropriate clinical care of indigenous wildlife casualties. She is the co-editor of the BSAVA Manual of Wildlife Casualties and author of several other publications on wildlife medicine.
